According to the ABPI, the British pharmaceutical industry generated £46.7 billion in turnover in 2021/22,

with the MedTech industry having a combined turnover of £34.3 billion according to the ABHI.

The vast majority of innovation activity in both pharmaceuticals and medical technology remains in the traditional economic hubs of the UK, sitting within the nation's largest cities and research hubs in London, Manchester, Cambridge and Oxford.

However, with footprints in Northern Ireland,
Scotland, Wales and the North East of England,
the importance of both sectors to long term
economic growth, and the subsequent
importance in the upcoming election, is clear.






